Transition to Polymer Bank Notes effective December 15, 2021

With effect from January 1, 2022, the Central Bank of Trinidad and Tobago has announced that only the new polymer banknotes will be legal tender for cash payments within Trinidad and Tobago.

To facilitate a smooth transition, effective **December 15, 2021**, J.D.Sellier+Co. will no longer be accepting \$1, \$5, \$10, \$20, and \$50 paper-based (cotton) banknotes with series dates prior to 2020 as legal tender. For your information, the redemption of these paper-based bank notes will be facilitated indefinitely at the Central Bank.

Payments at our offices can be made via Cheque, Online Bank (ACH) Transfer, Wire Transfer, Linx machine – Debit cards only or with the new Polymer Banknotes.
